

MATCH IN 3 PARTS WITHIN CIRCLES

Activity Typology: Party in 3 times

Material: Two-color circles, two-colored butt and a ball.

Description of the activity:

Two teams are formed. Around the field, two-color circles (one color for each team). Circles are created based on the number of people that play. For example, if 12 people play in total, 6 circles of one color, and 6 of the other, are created, distributed all over in the field.

A football match is played using the following rule: **Each participant chooses a circle and cannot leave it (at all times they must have at least one foot inside the circle).**

Variantes:

The following variants with position changes are valid if the safety distance is respected during travel.

- V1:** When signaled, all participants change circles, and the match continues. Can only change circles for the team which they are a part of.
- V2:** When signaled, all people change circles and continue the match. You can occupy any of the circles on the pitch.
- V3:** More circles are placed than people (*you can place twice as many circles as people playing*). All participants can change and move to the circles they want, but they can only touch the ball (*to pass or kick*) if they have one foot inside the circle.
- V4:** Game rules and variants may apply in basketball or handball matches.

Questions for reflection:

- Did you have fun?
- What did you like most about the match?
- Have all agreed standards been respected?
- Have all the passes and shots been with at least one foot inside the circle?
- Has the safety distance been maintained if there have been changes of position?
- Do you think you've all worked hard?
