

**Activity Typology:** Collective play

**Material:** A towel, a ball or roll of toilet paper and a bucket.

### Description of the activity:

The objective of the game is to make the ball or roll of toilet paper inside a bucket or similar container. The ball or paper cannot be touched with your hands or any other part of your body and must be thrown using a towel. The game ends when the two or more people make the ball or paper inside the bucket. It can be repeated as many times as you want.

### Variants:

**V1:** The challenge is to make the maximum number of baskets among all the people in the group. For a certain period of time, each participant must make as many baskets as possible. When time is up, the baskets made by each participant will be added and the group result will be obtained. The cooperative challenge can then be repeated in order to overcome the previous result.

**V2:** The challenge is to hit the ball or roll of paper 3 times in a row by punching like in tennis. The following actions are performed:

1. Throw the ball or roll into the air
2. The ball or roll is hit with your hand (as if the hand were a shovel or racket) pointing towards the basket.

A new challenge can be posed, and the difficulty increased, by agreeing to a new number of hits before scoring (5, or 7, or 10...).

**V3:** The ball or roll of toilet paper is placed in a high place (e.g. a table) and the bucket is placed on the ground near the table. The goal of the game is to make the ball or toilet paper roll into the bucket by blowing. You cannot touch the ball or roll of paper with any part of the body to score; it can only be done by blowing.

### Questions for reflection:

- Did you like the game? Was it fun?
- How was it making it in with a towel? Have you ever played with a towel before? In what other ways can you use a towel to play?
- What value do you think has been most important in this game?
- In what other spaces do you put this value into practice? At home, at school, on the street, on public transport...? And in what situations?
